

Freedom Pass circuit

Section 21: Amersham to Chesham

Distance: 3.10 mi, 4.96 km

Introduction

This is a short straightforward section that takes us north to the most northwesterly point of the circuit.

There are places to eat in Amersham and Chesham.

Directions

Leave Amersham Station by the main entrance, next to platform 3, and turn left.

Go down the hill to the second mini-roundabout, then turn right, away from the railway.

At the next roundabout, turn left down Rectory Hill.

Then turn right along Longfield Drive.

At the end turn right.

Keep straight ahead across two roads, and turn right at the third one.

At the mini-roundabout, turn left, then immediately cross the main road at the lights, and carry on into the woods.

Bear left onto a path which gradually diverges from the main road.

Cross the first road, bearing slightly left.

Keep straight head, then go straight across an oblique crossing, then bear right downhill.

Cross another road bearing right, then go through the staggered wooden barriers, and proceed alongside a wooden fence on the right.

Follow the path straight ahead. You will have Chesham Bois Wood on the right at first, then later it will be on both sides.

When you get to a fork, keep right down the hill.

Exit the wood by the kissing gate.

Turn right after another kissing gate.

Go under the railway, and carry on to the right bend.

Turn left along Millfields.

This takes you back under the railway. Then fork left.

Cross the main road, and turn right along the pavement.

Go straight ahead at the roundabout, across Amy Lane.

Just after the bridge, take the footpath on the left.

Follow the path alongside the river (do not cross it) all the way to the end.

At the end, turn right along the road.

Cross the main road and carry on across the Market Square and up the High Street.

Turn right up Station Road a little before the war memorial.

At the top of the hill, turn right to reach Chesham Station.
