

Freedom Pass circuit

Section X1: West Drayton to Iver

Distance: 2.91 mi, 4.66 km

Introduction

This is a fairly short section. Iver is pretty much a dead end, there being no obvious route beyond to Langley and Slough. So it would probably be preferable to follow the alternative route which goes directly from West Drayton to Slough.

There is a conveniently placed pub on the approaches to Iver.

Directions

Leave West Drayton Station on the north side, by platform 5, and turn left.

Turn right at the mini-roundabout.

After going over the canal, turn right three times onto the towpath.

Leave the towpath at the next bridge, and turn left over the canal.

Keep straight on at the mini-roundabout.

After a right bend, bear left onto a bridleway.

At a fork, keep left, then turn left over a footbridge. Here we join the Colne Valley Trail.

Follow the path straight, then round a right bend, then straight again.

Just before a green barrier, turn left and go under the railway.

When you reach a road, turn right.

At the T junction turn left, then take the next right.

Turn left into Thorney Park.

After a left bend, before the track goes over Colne Brook, turn right and go under the motorway.

At the fork bear right. Here we leave the Colne Valley Trail.

Follow the path parallel to the motorway, and then round to the left.

At the end, go up the steps and turn right.

At the mini-roundabout turn left, then bear left along Somerset Way.

At the end, bear right.

Go straight ahead at the crossroads.

Iver Station will be on your right.
