

# Zone 5 circuit

## Section 9: Cheam to Stoneleigh

Distance: 2.14 mi, 3.42 km

### Introduction

This is a short section. The beginning and end are suburban; the middle part is through Nonsuch Park.

There are places to eat at both ends.

### Directions

Leave Cheam station on the north side, by platform 1.

When you reach The Railway, turn right along Station Way (but not the cul-de-sac).

Take the second left, which is Kingsway Road.

At the end, turn left along Anne Boleyn Walk.

Take the next right, which is Queens Acre.

At the end, after a change of name to Jubilee Road, cross the main road and turn left along the cycle track just beyond.

Carry straight on into Nonsuch Park.

Keep straight ahead past a red and white barrier.

Halfway down a slight descent, bear right onto a diagonal path, just after another path on the right.

Cross a wider track at a 5-way junction.

At the next crossroads, bear right.

Keep straight ahead towards a pine tree.

Just before you reach it, turn left onto a wider track.

Turn right (but not sharp right) under a sycamore tree onto a minor path, then left through a wooden gate.

Follow the diagonal path across the meadow, past a solitary oak.

Bear right through the carpark, to reach the main road.

Turn left, then take the first right, which is Park Avenue East.

Carry straight on at the roundabout.

At the end, turn right.

Keep straight on along Kenilworth Road.

At the end, turn left to reach Stoneleigh station.
