

# Zone 5 circuit

## Section 10: Stoneleigh to Tolworth

Distance: 2.58 mi, 4.13 km

### Introduction

This is a short section. Apart from a short suburban section at the start, it is entirely rural. The middle half follows the London Loop.

There is not much in the way of places to eat.

### Directions

Leave Stoneleigh station on the west side, by platform 1.

Turn left down Stoneleigh Park Road.

After a right bend, you come to a main road. Take the service road on the right, then cross the main road at the pedestrian crossing on the left.

Carry on straight ahead along Bradford Road.

At the end turn right, then take the footpath on the left between nos. 16 and 14.

At the end turn right.

At the end, carry on along the footpath straight ahead.

Turn left at the first junction, then right into Ewell Court Park.

Keep on the tarmac path, turning left alongside the lake when you reach a T junction.

Keep on the main path, and straight ahead at a 4-way junction.

Bear right at a fork.

Follow the main path round a bend to the right and out of the park.

Cross another tarmac path, and carry on straight ahead along a rougher path, with the Hogsmill on your left. We are now on the London Loop.

A tarmac path joins from the left, and branches off to the right.

Cross a main road, and carry on alongside the river.

Cross a tarmac path which crosses the river on your left.

Turn left over the next footbridge, which is green, and then right over a white footbridge.

Ahead are three paths across a meadow. Take the middle one, which aims slightly to the left of a large office building.

Keep straight ahead through a gap in a hedge.

Turn right at a large oak tree, then take the path which aims slightly to the left of the office building (now revealed to be Lidl).

Go down some steps, then turn left along the main road.

Cross Jubilee Way.

After the railway bridge, turn left to reach Tolworth station.
