

Zone 6 inner

Section 12: Chessington North to Surbiton

Distance: 3.08 mi, 4.93 km

Introduction

This is a fairly short section. It is nearly all through rather boring suburbs, with the exception of an unexpected very small wild area near the start.

There are places to eat in Surbiton.

Directions

Turn right out of Chessington North station, then right under the railway, and then right twice along Station Road.

Carry straight on up Sanger Avenue.

Cross the end of Coutts Avenue, then take the next left, which is also Coutts Avenue.

On the left bend, turn right into Bullwhips.

Keep generally straight on uphill, then follow the path round to the left as it starts to descend.

Leave the park on a tarmac path downhill.

At the end, turn right.

Turn left onto Durbin Road.

Turn right at the crossroads, by a busstop.

Turn right then immediately left into Cedarcroft Road.

At the end, bear left.

At the end, turn left.

Turn left alongside a dual carriageway.

Take the underpass.

At the top of the ramp on the far side, turn right across the service road, and carry on along a short footpath.

At the T junction turn left.

Carry straight on along a residential road, parallel to the dual carriageway, and follow it round to the right.

At the end, turn left then right into Thornhill Avenue.

At the end, turn left then right into Cotterill Road.

Take the first left, which is Malvern Road.

Carry straight on along the footpath.

Turn right along the main road.

At the first junction, turn left (not sharp left) along Southborough Road.

At the end, turn right along Langley Avenue.

Keep straight on at the miniroundabout.

Take the second left, which is Oakenshaw Close.

Keep going in the same direction, then follow the road, which is now Oak Hill, round to the right.

At the end, turn left along Oakhill Path.

At the end, turn right.

You will shortly reach Surbiton station on the left.
