

Zone 6 inner

Section 13: Surbiton to Kingston

Distance: 1.92 mi, 3.07 km

Introduction

This is a short and straightforward section. It mostly goes north along the south bank of the River Thames.

There are plenty of places to eat at both ends of the section.

Directions

Leave Surbiton station on the north side, by platform 1, and cross the forecourt.

Bear right at the mini-roundabout along Claremont Road.

Bear left in front of the clock tower.

Then turn right into Claremont Gardens, and carry on either path parallel to Claremont Road.

At the end, turn left along Grove Road.

Keep straight ahead at the crossroads.

At the end turn right and then left into Queens Promenade.

Follow the path alongside the Thames. When the path splits, take either branch. They merge back together a little later.

When you reach Kingston Town End Pier (Turks Boat Hire), there are two short sets of steps close together on the right. Go up either of them.

Cross High Street and bear left along South Lane.

Keep straight ahead past an off-white barrier, then bear left at a T junction.

Keep straight ahead past a multi-storey carpark on the right, then straight ahead along a footpath.

Turn left beside the Hogsmill, then right over Clattern Bridge.

Bear left into the Market Place.

Keep along the right-hand edge of the Market Place, and leave it along Church Street.

Turn right in front of the Benthall Centre.

Take the second left, which is Castle Street.

At the end, turn right.

Kingston station is on the opposite side of the main road.
