

Zone 6 inner

Section 17: Feltham to Hatton Cross

Distance: 2.20 mi, 3.52 km

Introduction

This is a short section. The first part is through parkland, which is pleasant enough. The second part is largely through an industrial estate, which is not particularly pleasant. But so close to Heathrow Airport, unpleasantness is more or less inevitable.

There is a pub near the end (right under the flight path).

Directions

Leave Feltham station on the north side, by platform 1.

Turn right over a stream, then immediately left along a path beside the stream.

At the first intersection, take the path roughly straight on, which diverges slightly away from the stream.

Keep straight on at the next intersection.

Bear right and cross an oval running track diagonally.

On the other side, keep going in the same general direction, alongside an embankment on your right.

Pass a carpark on the left, then proceed ahead, first along the left edge of an expanse of grass, and then diagonally across it.

Go through a kissing gate, then turn left along a residential road.

Turn right along Burns Avenue.

Turn left along the main road.

Go straight ahead at the traffic lights, crossing to the opposite pavement.

After crossing a stream, carry on along a service road on the right.

Turn right along Central Way.

Take the third left, which is Chalmers Way.

Follow this road round bends to the right, left, right and left again, as it changes its name to Space Way and then Heron Way.

At the traffic lights, go straight ahead along Green Man Lane.

Keep straight on past the Green Man, and straight on at the traffic light.

Hatton Cross station is at the next crossroads.
