

Zone 6 outer

Section 1: Slade Green to Barnehurst

Distance: 2.22 mi, 3.55 km

Introduction

There is not much to this section. Although most of it is through rather dreary suburbs, it is very short. At one point it is necessary to cross a dual carriageway and climb over a fence, but in practice this is not at all difficult.

There is a pub at the end.

Directions

Leave Slade Green station on the west side, by platform 1.

Immediately, before the road, go through the kissing gate on the right.

Follow the diagonal path across the rough grass.

Cross the road, and turn left along it.

Turn right immediately after a row of garages.

Shortly after a kissing gate, turn left.

Keep on the main path, through a kissing gate, across a residential road, and diagonally across another area of grass.

Turn left and immediately right, into Scott Crescent.

Turn right at the T junction.

Turn left between nos. 32 and 30.

Cross the dual carriageway and carry on along the footpath opposite.

At the end, turn right then left into Normandy Way.

At the end, turn left, then take the footpath on the right.

Carry on along Elmstead Road, then turn left at the T junction.

Follow this road for some distance. Just before a sharp right bend, take the footpath on the left between nos. 38 and 36.

At the end, turn left then right into Northumberland Way. Follow it round to the right.

At the end, turn left then right twice into Coniston Road.

Take the second left, which is Thirlmere Road.

At the end, turn left then right into Windemere Road.

Take the footpath on the left, between nos. 30 and 28.

Carry straight on across the next road to reach Barnehurst Station.
