

# Zone 6 outer

## Section 2: Barnehurst to Crayford

Distance: 2.40 mi, 3.84 km

### Introduction

This is another short section. After some harmless suburbia, most of the rest is fairly rural, including Martens Grove Park and the meadows by the River Cray.

There is a cafe at Hall Place, and pubs in Crayford.

### Directions

Leave Barnehurst station on the south side, by platform 1. From the London end: immediately turn left along the footpath; it initially runs parallel to the railway, then turns right away from it. From the country end: turn left at the T junction and follow the path round to the right.

Carry straight on across Northall Road into Beverley Road.

Bear right into Westfield Road.

Bear right again into Midfield Avenue.

Turn left then right, still in Midfield Avenue.

After the grass triangle on your left, cross the main road and bear left into Stephen Road.

Just after a left bend, enter Martens Grove on the right.

Take the second turning right, down a flight of steps.

At the bottom, turn right then bear left.

Follow the path up a slope, round to the left and then right, and out of Martens Grove.

Carry on straight ahead along Park Grove.

At the bottom, cross Watling Street and go up the steps opposite.

Turn left at the top and descend the residential street.

At the bottom, turn right into Halcot Avenue.

At the right bend, carry straight on to the left of the grass triangle.

After a green fence on the right, bear right, off the path, and go down an avenue of trees.

At the bottom you meet a metal fence. Skirt round it to the right and carry on towards the main road.

Leave the park by a kissing gate and cross the main road.

Enter Hall Place opposite, and keep straight ahead, past a carpark and kitchen garden on the right and another carpark on the left.

Cross the Cray by a footbridge, and turn left alongside it. In due course join a tarmac path.

Just before a kissing gate, turn right, away from the Cray, along the top of an embankment.

Just before the next corner, turn left down the embankment and through a kissing gate.

Keep straight ahead on the path, with the railway on your right, until eventually you reach Crayford station.
