Section 10-11: Tattenham Corner to Ewell East

Distance: 3.36 mi, 5.38 km

Introduction

This section is a combination of Sections 10 (Tattenham Corner to Epsom Downs) and 11 (Epsom Downs to Ewell East), avoiding Epsom Downs. It is pretty straightforward and flat. It proceeds northwards through Epsom and Ewell.

There are cafes at Tattenham Corner, and several pubs in Ewell.

Directions

Walk straight ahead out of Tattenham Corner station.

Turn right onto the road (Royal Drive) in front of the carpark.

Turn left at the roundabout and cross the road when the pavement ends.

When that pavement also ends, continue on the rough path on the right, down to Tattenham Corner Road, and turn right onto it.

Follow the road round to the left along the grass verge, crossing the ends of Tattenham Crescent and Old London Road.

Then take the diagonal footpath on the right across the grass. If there is fencing in the way, skirt round it to the right and join the path on the other side.

Keep on the path through the woods, across Grand Stand Road, and gradually downhill through a golf course.

Just after the path bends right, turn left, past a green on your left.

Keep straight ahead on this path over several intersections until you reach an intersection with a metal gate ahead. Bear right in front of it onto a bridleway alongside a wooden fence.

Cross a road. Then keep straight ahead on the path all the way to the end.

When you reach the road, cross it and turn right along it.

Take the next left, which is Lynwood Road.

At the end, turn right onto College Road, then immediately take the footpath on the left before No. 25.

At the end, turn left.

Take the next right, which is Bridle Road.

The road soon becomes a path. Keep straight ahead along it, across several more roads, through an area of bijou stockbroker residences.

Carry straight on across a main road, reaching open countryside. Turn left at the next intersection.

Turn right just before the railway bridge.

You will shortly come to Ewell East station on the left.
