

# Zone 6 outer

## Section 16: Hampton to Feltham

Distance: 4.01 mi, 6.42 km

### Introduction

This section takes us north-west round the edge of Kempton Nature Reserve and through Hanworth Park. This section is identical to Section 15 of the Freedom Pass Circuit.

There are places to eat in Hampton and Feltham.

### Directions

Leave Hampton station on the north side, by platform 1, and turn left.

Turn right into Percy Road then immediately left into Linden Road. Follow the road round to the right.

Turn left into Bloxall Crescent

Turn right into Wembley Road, and carry straight on along the footpath.

At the end turn left.

Take the second turning right, which is Markhole Close. Keep straight ahead along the footpath.

At the end turn left.

At the end turn right into Hatherop Road.

At the T junction turn left into Hatherop Park.

Follow the main path, past a play area on the right, round a right and a left bend and then straight ahead.

Eventually the path narrows, bends right and goes through a gate in a metal fence.

Turn left and follow the path slightly downhill between two metal fences (not always visible through the vegetation), until you come to a pair of gates and a short length of half-buried railway track. Here turn right along the bridleway.

At the end, cross the road and bear left along Church Road.

On reaching the dual carriageway, go over the footbridge.

On the other side, turn right and proceed along the footpath into the trees with the dual carriageway on the right and playing fields on the left.

Keep going alongside the playing fields' access road.

Turn left when you reach the ramps and steps on the right.

When the road bends right, bear left onto the footpath by the green barrier.

Turn right into the carpark, and go along its right-hand edge. Keep on the sandy path into Hanworth Park.

When the sandy path bends right, carry on straight ahead on the grass path, towards a couple of benches.

As you reach the benches, keep going in the same direction across a rugger pitch.

On the other side of the pitch, take the left-most of three mown grass paths, proceeding in the same general direction as before.

Cross a concrete path and keep going, still in the same direction, through a gap between the trees and then towards the left-most visible house. Cross a sandy path.

As you approach the edge of the park, bear left twice on sandy paths.

Follow the path, with a green fence on your left, out of the park.

Turn left alongside the road, cross at the zebra crossing, and carry on through the trees.

Go straight ahead along Danesbury Road, towards the church.

Take the footpath left, just past the Cardinal Centre.

Cross the river and then turn right.

This takes you to the High Street. Turn right, and you will shortly come to Feltham station on the left.
